

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## **ABOUT THE WMC**

- Independent, full authority, regulator of allopathic physicians and physician assistants.
- Operates as a hybrid/remote organization.
- Collaborates with the DOH under a joint operating agreement.
- WMC published their 2023-2025 Strategic Plan.

## ACTIONS IN FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2024

- Issued 4,429 new licenses.
- Received 2,002 complaints/reports.
- Completed legal process on 536 investigations.

## SIGNIFICANT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Instituted a Practitioner Support Program to provide helpful resources to physicians and physician assistants.
- Instituted a program to help complainants provide information needed to review their complaints.
- The WMC was recognized as a WellBeing First Champion for 2023 and is among twenty-one other U.S. states who have made these changes to protect practitioner health. In order to receive this award, ALL IN: WellBeing First for Healthcare, a coaltion of leading health care organizations, has verified the WMC Licensure applications are free from intrusive and stigmatizing language around mental health care and treatment. The WMC offers a "safe haven" provision in our application.
