The Clinical Support Plan is not reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank or the Federation of State Medical Boards. The Clinical Support Plan will not be posted on the Department of Health web site and will not be listed in the Commission newsletter. However, it is a public document under the Public Records Act, chapter 42.56.
