

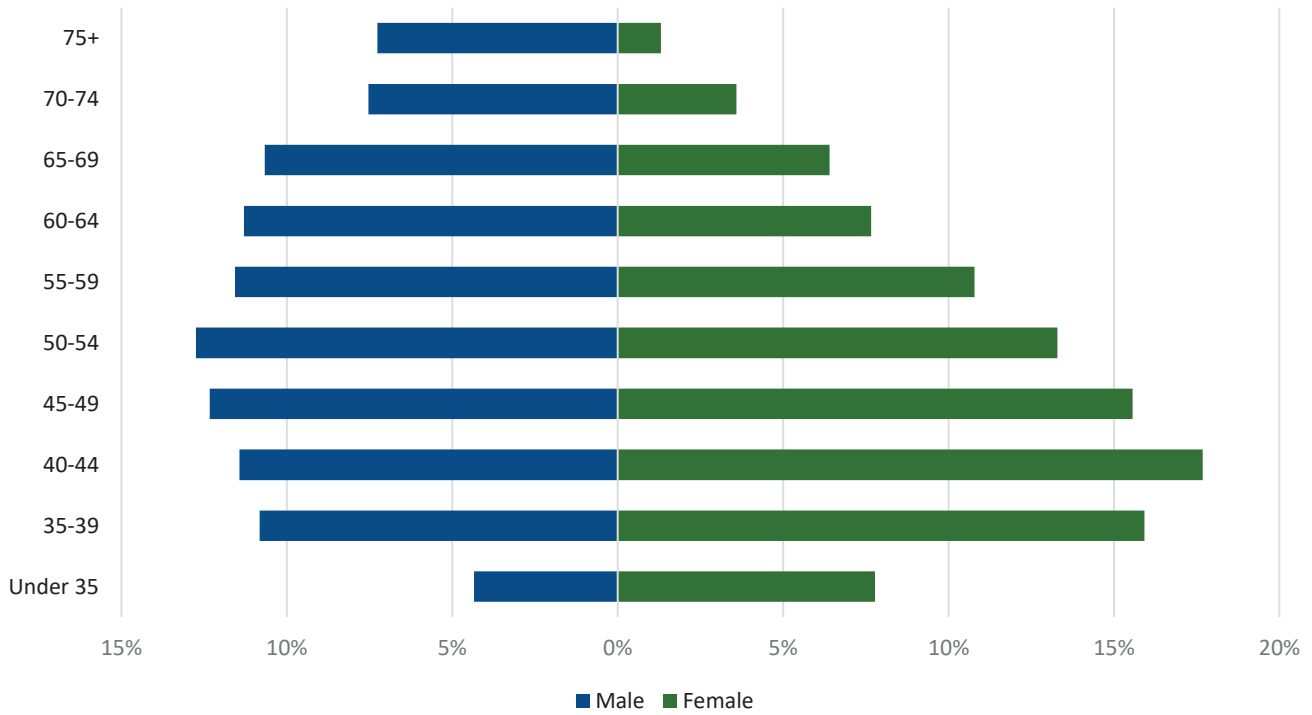

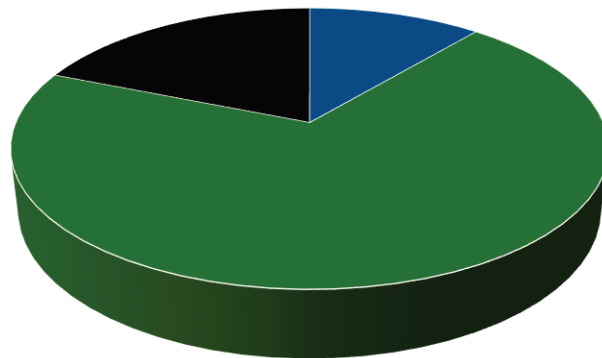

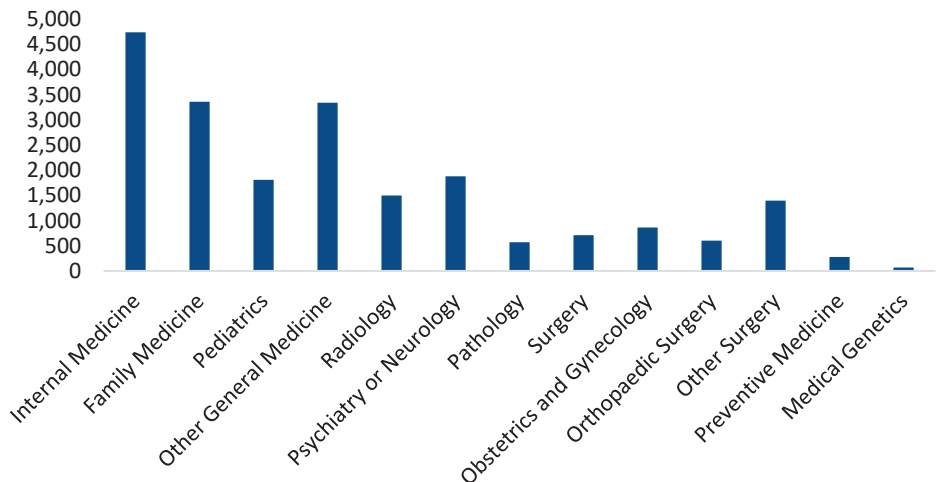

**Physician principal area of practice and counties with practice sites - Southwest Washington**



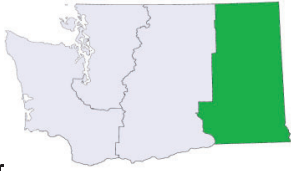
