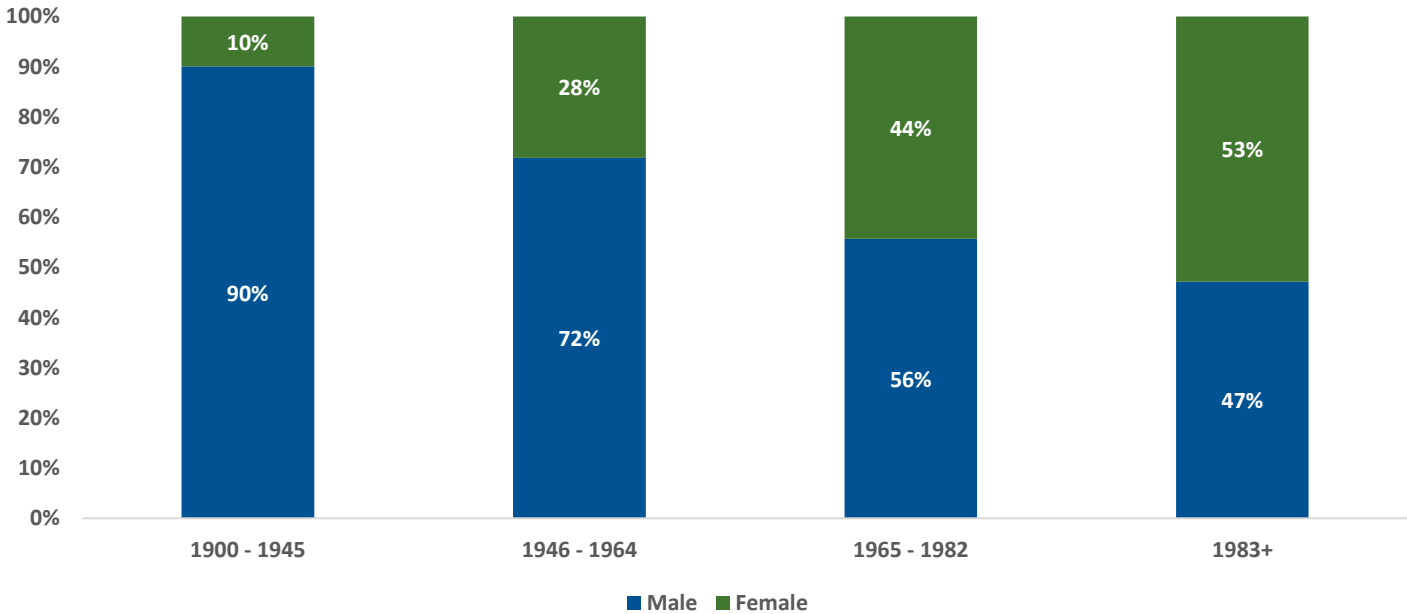

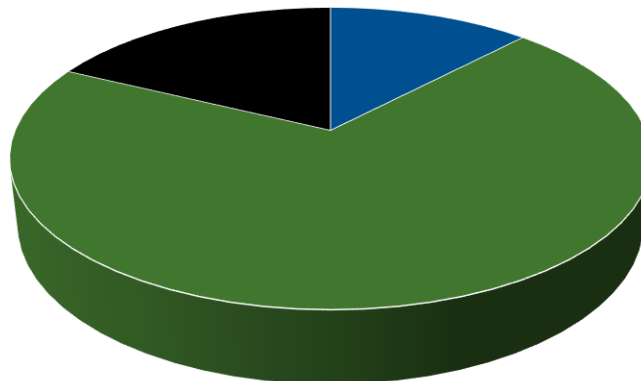

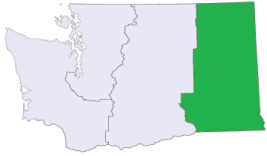
Physician principal area of practice and counties with practice sites - Central Washington
